Skydive Jamaica's operating aircraft is an expertly-maintained King Air 90 which seats 14 passengers plus their FAA certified pilot. Their Tandem skydiving instructors have on average over 4,000 skydives each and they offer video capabilities so that clients will remember every aspect of their dive, including the exciting freefall at speeds of up to 150 m.p.h.

Skydive Jamaica is open from 8:00 am until sunset, and reservations are accepted seven days a week.
