

Government pledges J\$1 million to assist degenerative children

The Government of Jamaica has pledged J\$1 million support to the Menzies family whose three children suffer a neuro-degenerative disorder.

The announcement was made at this morning's (Jan 20) National Leadership Prayer Breakfast at the Jamaica Pegasus Hotel by Prime Minister Bruce Golding where he read the first lesson.

The Menzies family is from St. Ann. The children, ages- nine; five and four; were born healthy but now suffer from neuro-degenerative disorder- a diverse group of rare diseases which causes loss of speech, hearing, vision, intellect and strength.
