
Jamaica Welcomes New Flights From Delta And Frontier

Jamaica continues to appeal to visitors as an easily accessible Caribbean destination with the introduction of new, seasonal nonstop flights courtesy of Delta Air Lines and Frontier Airlines

Sangster International Airport (MBJ) in Montego Bay will welcome weekly Delta flights from Indianapolis International Airport (IND), and weekly Frontier flights from Denver International Airport (DEN), beginning December 21 and 22, respectively.
